Practice Direction (No. 1 of 2020) pursuant to section 12(8) of the Companies Act 2001, section 41A(4) of Limited Liability Partnership Act 2016, section 2 of Limited Partnerships Act and section 36(6) Foundation Act 2015

Disclosure of Beneficial Ownership information to the Registrar.

- Every company or any other entity must enter in alphabetical order, the names of the Beneficial Owner or Ultimate Beneficial Owner in its register.
- The CBRD should be informed of any new issue or transfer entailing a change in the Beneficial Ownership Information.
- This information is required to be filed at the counter of the CBRD, within 14 days of entry or alteration made to the register.
- 4. The Registrar would only disclose the above information to any third party in the following circumstances:
  - (a) if it is required by the Beneficial Owner or the Ultimate Beneficial Owner.
  - (b) For the purpose of an investigation, enquiry, or any similar matter.
  - (c) If ordered by a Court of Law or the Judge in Chambers.
- The company shall keep such information for 7 years and any amendment made to the register.
- Records of the existing Beneficial Ownership information must be communicated to the CBRD at any time prior to or upon filing of the next annual return.
- 7. For the above purpose Beneficial or Ultimate Beneficial Owner means a natural person who holds by himself or his nominee a share or interest in a share which entitles him to exercise not less than 20% of the aggregate voting power in a meeting of shareholders/partners or council members.
- Failure to comply with the above provisions amounts to an offence which is liable to a fine not exceeding 300,000 rupees.
- This Practice Direction applies to a limited Partnership, a Foundation and a limited liability Partnership.
