PRACTICE DIRECTION NO. 1 OF 2010

Re-submission of documents pursuant to Section 12 of the Companies Act 2001 and Regulations G.N. No. 161 of 2010

This Practice Direction is issued pursuant to Section 12(8) of the Companies Act 2001.

 Companies are reminded that in accordance with Section 12(3) of the Companies Act 2001, a prescribed fee is payable if a document which has been refused is submitted again to be filed.

The fees payable are as follows: -

(a) Re-submission of document within 7 days of collection date

Rs. 100/-

(b) Penalty for re-submission of document after the 7 days period Rs: 50/- per month or part of a month

- (2) The refused document can be amended or completed or a fresh document can be re-submitted.
- (3) The mention "Re-submitted" should be clearly mentioned on the amended/fresh document.
- (4) All refused document which has not been collected is deemed not to have been filed and will be disposed of by the office.
