

General Notice No. 1758 of 2010

PRACTICE DIRECTION NO. 1 OF 2010

*Re-submission of documents pursuant to Section 12 of the Companies Act 2001 and
Regulations G.N. No. 161 of 2010*

This Practice Direction is issued pursuant to Section 12(8) of the Companies Act 2001.

1. Companies are reminded that in accordance with Section 12(3) of the Companies Act 2001, a prescribed fee is payable if a document which has been refused is submitted again to be filed.

The fees payable are as follows: -

(a) Re-submission of document *within* Rs. 100/-
7 days of collection date

(b) Penalty for re-submission of document Rs: 50/- per month or
after the 7 days period part of a month

- (2) The refused document can be amended or completed or a fresh document can be re-submitted.
- (3) The mention "**Re-submitted**" should be clearly mentioned on the amended/fresh document.
- (4) All refused document which has not been collected is deemed not to have been filed and **will be disposed of by the office.**
