

General Notice No. 850 of 2017, Government Gazette No. 58 of 17th June 2017

Practice Direction No 2 of 2017 pursuant to Section 12(8) of the Companies Act 2001.

Power of the Registrar to dispense with the word “Limited” or “Limitée” in a limited liability company.

1. A company or a proposed company is hereby informed that pursuant to Section 33 of the Companies Act 2001 as amended by the Business Facilitation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 2017 and this Practice Direction, the Registrar’s written approval is required for the dispensation with the word “limited” or “limitée” or the abbreviation “Ltd” or “Ltée” in its name.
2. The approval of the Registrar will be given only when the constitution of the company/proposed company provides the following:-
 - (i) that the company/proposed company has as object, the promotion of commerce, art, science, religion, charity or other useful object;
 - (ii) that the company/proposed company intends to apply its profits or other income in promoting its objects;
 - (iii) that the company/proposed company prohibits the payment of any dividend to its members.
