THE INSOLVENCY ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 411 of the Insolvency Act

1. These regulations maybe cited as the **Insolvency (Remuneration of Liquidator) Regulations 2019**.

2. In these regulations —

"Act" means the Insolvency Act.

3. The maximum remuneration that a liquidator is entitled to claim, in respect of the gross realisation proceeds set out in the first column of the Schedule, shall, pursuant to section 111 (2)(c)(i) of the Act, and, where he has been provided with an indemnity cover, be the corresponding percentage set out in the second column of that Schedule.

Where there is no indemnity cover, the maximum remuneration that a liquidator is entitled to claim, pursuant to section 111(2)(c)(ii), shall, in respect of the gross realisation proceeds set out in the first column of the Schedule, be the corresponding percentage set out in the second column of that Schedule, plus 5 per cent.
