

THE COMPANIES ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under sections 355 and 360 of the Companies Act

1. These regulations may be cited as the Companies (waiving of Fees) Regulations 2009.

2. In these regulations -

“handicraft enterprise” has the same meaning as in the Small Enterprises and Handicraft Development Authority Act:

“small enterprise” has the same meaning as in the Small Enterprises and Handicraft Development Authority Act.

3. Notwithstanding the Companies (Fees payable to Registrar) Regulations 2001, where a handicraft enterprise or a small enterprise –

- (a) operated by a person, other than a company, is converted into a company; or
- (b) is incorporated as a company,

from the commencement of these regulations to 31 December 2010, the fees payable to the Registrar on the incorporation of the company shall be waived.
