Implementation of Fast Track Counter

The Corporate and Business Registration Department (CBRD) is pleased to inform its stakeholders and the public of the introduction of a Fast Track Counter, as part of its ongoing commitment to enhancing service delivery and improving the ease of doing business in Mauritius.

With effect from Monday 20 April 2026, applications for the incorporation of companies will be processed on a fast track basis.

Registration by Continuation – Revised Requirements

In line with efforts to simplify procedures and reduce administrative burden, the following documents will no longer be required when submitting an application for registration by continuation:

- Legal Opinion
- Duly authenticated Certificate of Deregistration in the country of origin

Applicants are, however, advised that the company will be required to **satisfy the solvency test immediately after registration**, as opposed to prior to registration.

The CBRD remains committed to continuous improvement and to providing efficient, transparent and customer-focused services.
